

Make a Model Ark

The ark was a wooden box covered with gold. Figures of two angels sat on the lid of the ark. Long poles were used to carry it.

In Israel the ark was the symbol, or sign, of God's presence. The ark belonged in the tabernacle, where Israel worshiped. Read about it in Exodus 37:1-9.

Make a model ark to remind you that our God is powerful and that he is with you. Get a small box and cover it with gold paper. Cut out cardboard angels and color them gold or cover them with gold paper. Then glue them to the top of the box. You can buy small sticks, called dowels, at a hardware or hobby store. Glue them to the side of your box. You could use straws too.

Put the model ark in your room as a reminder of God's presence.
