

Believe God's Promise

God promised Abram that he would have a son and more descendants than Abram could count. Read Genesis 15:1–6. Abram was 85 years old and had no children when God gave him this promise, but he believed God anyway and had faith that God would fulfill the promise. God then said that Abram's faith made Abram righteous before God.

You can become righteous before God by believing in God's Son, Jesus. Jesus died on the cross to save you and make you righteous before God. If you have never believed that Jesus is your Savior, or if you are not sure, write down this prayer on a piece of paper and sign it:

"I believe that Jesus is my Savior. Thank you, God, that I am now righteous before you and that you will take me to heaven when I die."
