

Your Branch of the Family Tree

Lists of names in the Bible seem very boring. But the Hebrew people were proud of their ancestors. They kept careful records, called "genealogies," listing their grandparents and great-grandparents and great-great-grandparents and so on.

Today we call genealogical records "family trees." Make a family tree out of a small artificial Christmas tree or some other type of stand. Ask your mom or dad to help you get pictures of each person. Attach the pictures to your family tree. On the back of the picture write one interesting fact about him or her.

Then decide with your parents on a title for your family tree. Maybe your title will be "hard workers," or "Michigan farmers," or "people helpers" or "praying Christians." Choose a title that says something about your family.
