

What Is Important About You?

Read 1 Samuel 16:1–13. When Samuel saw the first of Jesse's sons, he thought he knew who Israel's next king would be. But he was looking at the wrong thing—at the outside or physical appearance of the person. What part of a person is important to God?

Cut a heart from red construction paper. Make it large enough to cover your face if you tape the heart to a mirror. On the heart write something that God thinks is important in a person who loves him, like "helpful," "caring," "honest" or "friendly."

Put up the heart where you will see it, to help you remember that what is really important about you is the kind of person you are on the inside.
