Keep in Touch

The apostle Paul had friends he cared about, and he wrote letters to them. Read 1 Thessalonians 3:6–10.

Do you have a pen pal? Pen pals are friends with whom you exchange letters or email. If you've moved, children you knew from before can be good pen pals. So can cousins who live in a different city or town. If you don't have a pen pal, you can write to a child in a missionary family to see whether he or she would like to write back and forth with you.

When you write to your pen pals, pray for them just as Paul prayed for his friends when he wrote.
