Read Acts 9:1–31. Look carefully at the kind of person Saul (Paul) was before he was converted (Acts 9:1–2). What kind of person was he after his conversion (Acts 9:20–22, 27–28)?

Draw “before” and “after” pictures of Paul’s face. How do you think Saul looked when he hated Christians? How do you think Paul looked when he loved Jesus and wanted others to love Jesus too?

Put the “before” and “after” pictures on your wall to remind you that anyone can be converted by trusting Jesus and can become a new and different person. Let the pictures remind you to pray for others who have not yet turned their hearts to Jesus.
