No Unimportant People

Read Isaiah 42:1–4. In verse 3 the bruised reed and smoldering wick stand for "unimportant" people. No one will be unimportant when Jesus, God's servant, comes to make everything right.

You can show that all people are important as Bryce did in this true story. No one liked Ben. He was overweight and not very nice. When the kids on the playground lined up to play kickball, Ben went on one side—and everyone else in the fourth grade went on the other! Bryce thought that wasn't very nice. After a minute, he went over to be on Ben's side. Then some of the other kids followed Bryce.

Is there someone in your class who doesn't have any friends? Think of ways that you can be kind to that person. Remember that everyone matters to God.
