

Keep On Doing What Is Right

Sometimes people break promises to God. Read Jeremiah 34:8–16. Jeremiah told the Israelites in this story that it was wrong for them to keep another Israelite as a slave. They agreed together to free their slaves, but afterward they changed their minds and did wrong again. Jeremiah 34:11 tells what they did.

Trace around your foot on green and then on red construction paper. Cut out at least ten footprints of each color. When you do something you know is right, write what you did on one of the green footprints and tape it to the wall of your room. Start halfway up the wall and point the green footprint up. If you do something that is wrong, write what you did on one of the red footprints. Tape it to the wall, but point this footprint down. The footprints will show you which road you are traveling: God's road, doing what is right; or the road toward punishment, doing what is wrong.
