Read Matthew 18:10–14. In this story the sheep are God's children and God is the shepherd. Wandering off and getting lost is doing something wrong or sinful. After reading this passage, answer these questions: How does God feel about his children? What does God do when we sin? How does God feel when we confess our sins and are "found"?

Cut the figure of a sheep out of cardboard. For wool, glue cotton on one side of the sheep. On the other side write, "He is happy about the one sheep that is found." Put the sheep in your room to remind you that God loves you even when you have done something wrong.
