

A “Do Good” Plan

The people of Judah confessed their sins (Nehemiah 9). Then they did something else. They promised God that they would do better and even put their promises in writing (Nehemiah 9:38). To find out what the people of Judah promised God they would do, read Nehemiah 10:28–39.

When we sin it is important to tell God we are sorry. It is also important to plan how to do good in the future.

You can plan ahead to please God. Get a sheet of notebook paper. Write down one thing you will do to please God this week. Write your “do good” plan as a letter to God. Begin as the people in Nehemiah’s time did, by writing, “I promise . . .”
