

Memorize Scripture

Read Psalm 119:9–16. To hide God's Word in your heart (Psalm 119:11) means to memorize a verse and then to do what it says. Here are fun ways to memorize Bible verses with a friend.

1. Read the verse aloud, but leave out one word. Have your friend fill in the word you left out. Take turns reading the verse, and each time leave out a different word.
2. Each time you read the verse aloud leave out one more word. The first time, one word; the second time, two words; and so on. You or your friend can fill in the words that were left out.
3. Write the Bible verse on two cards. Cut out each word, and scramble the pieces of each card separately. See who can put the words in the right order in the shortest time.
