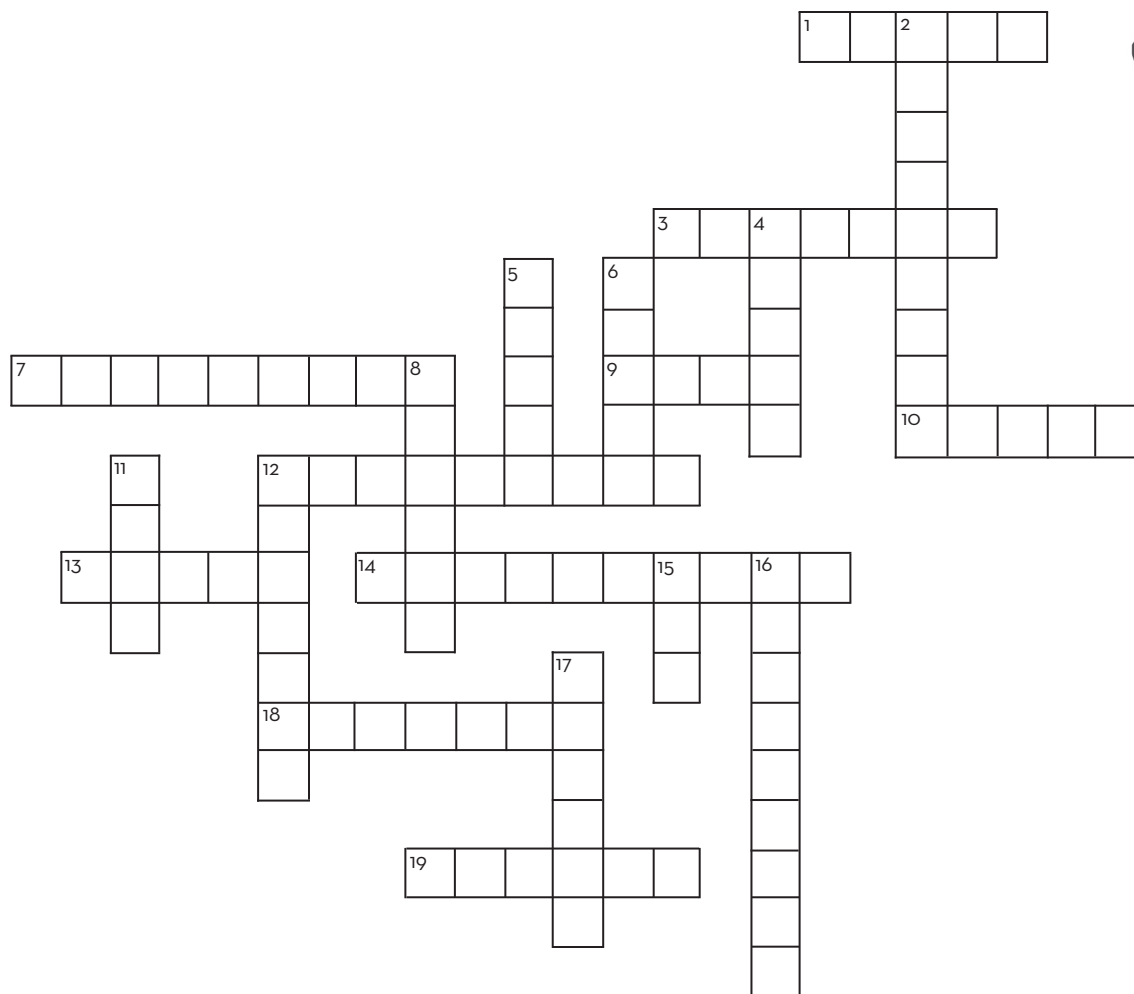


## THE TABERNACLE AND THE TEMPLE

### ACROSS

- The temple was made of large blocks of \_\_\_\_\_ taken from a quarry (1 Kings 5).
- In front of the temple were two bronze \_\_\_\_\_, one named Jakin and the other named Boaz (1 Kings 7).
- The temple was built in the city of \_\_\_\_\_ (2 Chronicles 3).
- When lumber was needed for the inside of the temple, King Solomon wrote a letter to the king of \_\_\_\_\_, asking him to send logs (2 Chronicles 2).
- God gave Moses the plans for the tabernacle while Moses was on Mount \_\_\_\_\_ (Exodus 19-31).

- The tabernacle had a golden \_\_\_\_\_ with branches that held oil lamps; the temple had ten of these (Exodus 25; 2 Chronicles 4).
- When Solomon became king of Israel, he built a special building called the \_\_\_\_\_, in which God lived with the Israelites in their new homeland (2 Chronicles 3).
