## MOSES AND THE ISRAELITES *Answer key*

1. Because Pharaoh ordered his people to kill all Hebrew baby boys, Moses's mother put Moses in a basket and hid it in the reeds along the bank of the Nile River (Exodus 2).
2. Pharaoh's daughter found Moses among the reeds along the riverbank, and she adopted him as her son (Exodus 2).
3. After killing an Egyptian, Moses ran away to live in a place called Midian (Exodus 2).
4. While Moses was tending sheep, God spoke to him through a burning bush (Exodus 3).
5. God told Moses to go to Pharaoh and bring God's people, the Israelites, out of Egypt (Exodus 3).
6. When Moses said that he wasn't a good speaker, God told him that his brother, Aaron, would speak for him (Exodus 4).
7. After Moses told Pharaoh to let God's people go, Pharaoh refused and said that the Israelites would have to make bricks without using straw (Exodus 5).
8. When Aaron threw his staff down in front of Pharaoh, it turned into a snake (Exodus 7).
9. Pharaoh wouldn't let the Israelites leave, so God sent ten plagues on the Egyptians (Exodus 7-11).
10. In the final plague, every firstborn son in Egypt was struck down and died (Exodus 11-12).
11. God told the Israelites to kill an animal and put its blood on their doorways so the final plague wouldn't touch them; this animal was called the Passover lamb (Exodus 12).
12. Pharaoh let the Israelites go, but then he and his army pursued them, and God parted the Red Sea so the Israelites could cross it and escape (Exodus 13-14).
13. God went ahead of the Israelites in a pillar of cloud by day and a pillar of fire by night (Exodus 13).
14. In the desert, when the Israelites were hungry and needed food, God sent quail and a special kind of bread called manna (Exodus 16).
15. When the Israelites were thirsty and needed something to drink, God gave them water from a rock (Exodus 17).
16. When Moses was on Mount Sinai, God gave him a set of laws called the Ten Commandments (Exodus 19-20).
17. Coming down from the mountain, Moses saw that the Israelites had begun to worship a golden calf (Exodus 32).
18. Following God's instructions, the Israelites built a special tent, called a tabernacle, where God could meet with them as they traveled through the desert (Exodus 36).
19. Because the Israelites disobeyed God by not entering the Promised Land when he told them to, God said they would live in the desert for forty years (Numbers 14).
20. Moses died on Mount Nebo, after God showed him the Promised Land (Deuteronomy 34).
